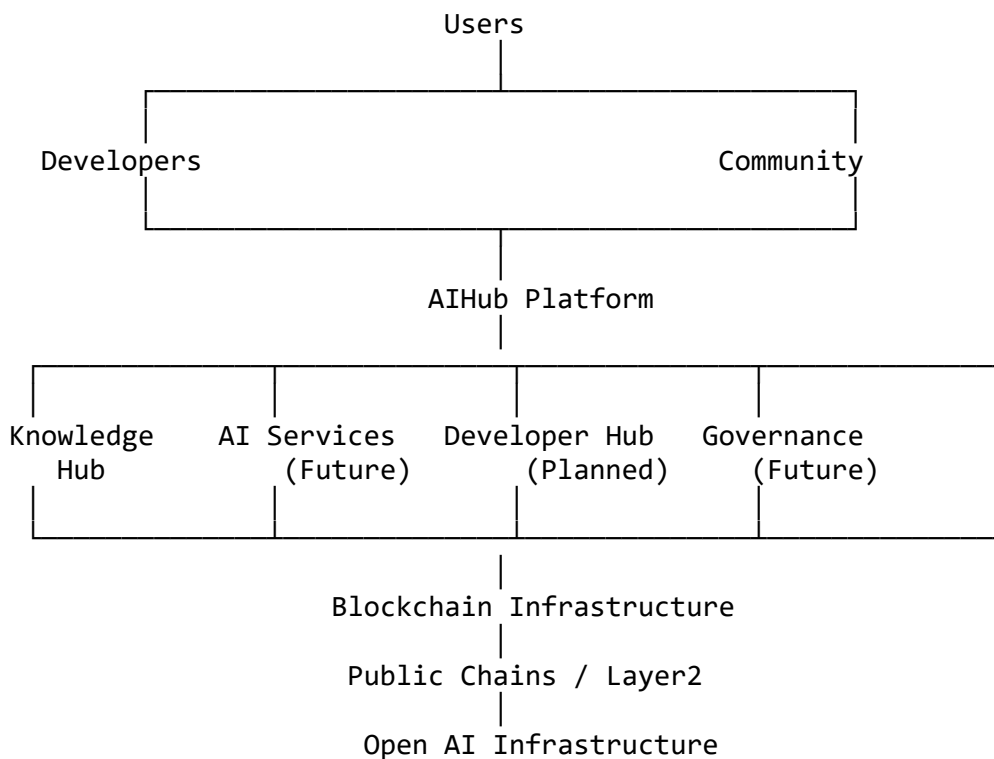
Innovation is not a milestone.

These tokens follow long-term vesting schedules.

Distribution will prioritize long-term alignment rather than short-term incentives.

12. Vesting Strategy
